

TFAC Covid Policies and Procedures for TFAC Ticketed Events in the Veh Auditorium

As of 3/17/22

To reduce exposure to COVID-19 for patrons, artists, staff and volunteers, Tryon Fine Arts Center (TFAC) is taking every precaution to make it safe for you to attend live performances. Effective March 17, 2022, masks are welcome but not required. TFAC staff and volunteers will continue to wear masks during events.

TFAC will continue to monitor guidance from the CDC, state and local agencies to protect the health of audiences and artists.

All staff, volunteers and patrons are requested to stay home if they've been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid 19, or if they're currently experience Covid 19-like symptoms.

Additional precautions for your safety are in place at TFAC including:

- All spaces within Tryon Fine Arts Center are protected by Aerus Pure & Clean technology, which has a scientifically proven reduction rate of over 99.9% of airborne SARS-CoV-2 novel coronavirus within 3 minutes. ActivePure Technology actively and continuously disinfects surfaces and air 24/7, minimizing contamination, recontamination and cross contamination in real time.
- The building's HVAC system has been optimized to maximize ventilation and outdoor airflow. All systems use filters at the highest merv factor that works safely with our system.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the lobbies, restrooms, and backstage areas.
