- *Allowable costs*: Funds may be used for contracted services (visiting artists, speakers, performers), materials, supplies, audiovisuals, software, hardware, educational field trips, and equipment.

- I agree to allow for planned observations arranged by TFAC.
- I will allow any creative work, tangible or intangible, which is developed through the use of this classroom grant, to be used by TFAC Arts in Education to promote the BIG grant program, whether it be through media releases, its website, presentations, or printed material.
- I agree to file a report summary by the deadline stated in my award letter, with proper documentation, and if applicable, return unspent funds that total more than 10% of the amount granted.
- I understand that grant-funded materials and equipment will remain within my school district.
- In all my own publicity efforts, I will credit the sponsor (if applicable) and the "Tryon Fine Arts Center Arts in Education" using the wording recommended in the award letter.
